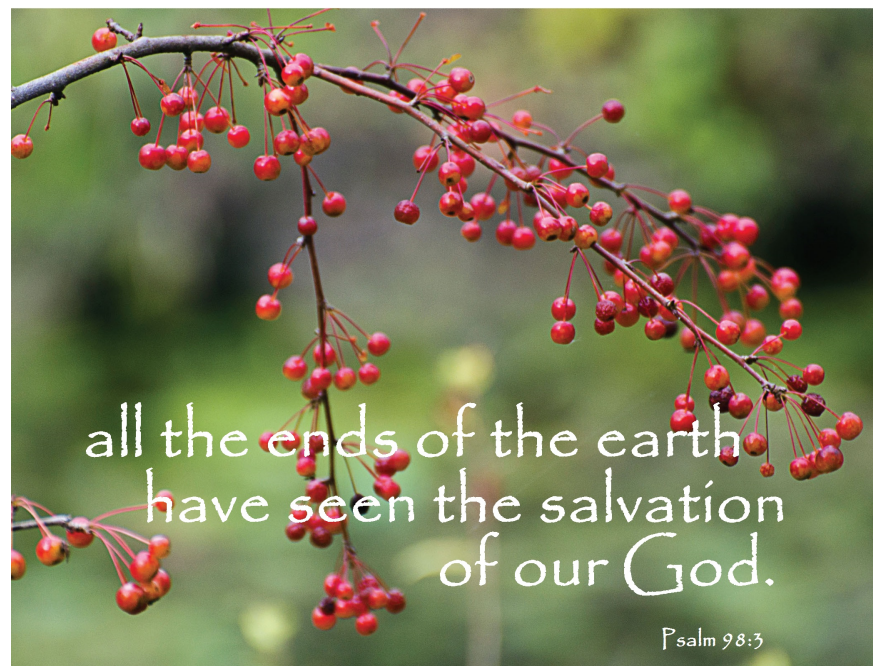

Follow the signs for Kelly Forks. Follow this road for 30 miles until you cross the North Fork of the Clearwater. After crossing the river, turn right, and begin to look for signs with "Hill" or "Hill Baptism" on them. It may be 2 or 3 miles, up to 15 miles to their campsite! Your trip will probably take 3 ½ hours! Baptism will be around 4:30 -5:00 p.m.
