KIP AULT WHO WORKS WITH the mission organization Gospel Outreach requests that you pray for the Adventist school located in Tokmok, Kyrgyzstan. Last week the government of Kyrgyzstan told administrators at the primary school that it wanted them to change their registration away from being Christian. This would mean that we would not be able to teach religious subjects and would have to become a secular school. Please pray that God moves in some way that our school can continue its witness to students in Tokmok. This is the only SDA school in the entirety of Central Asia. It exists because Kyrgyzstan has been less hostile to religious groups than other Central Asian nations. Numerous factors, including this registration change, seem to point in the direction that Kyrgyzstan is becoming less and less tolerant to Christianity.
