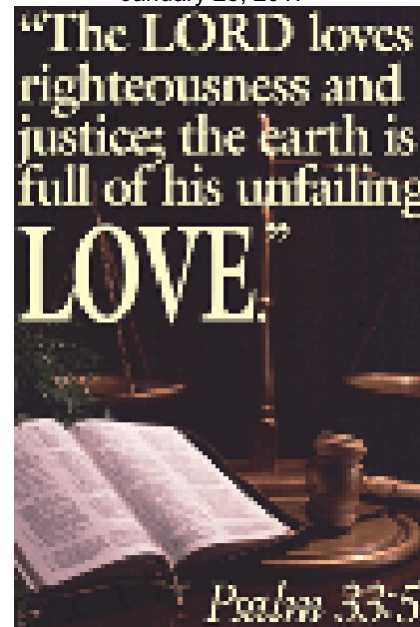

The cases of two Seventh-day Adventist, Adell Sherbert and Paula Hobbie, who lost their jobs over the Sabbath, went to the United States Supreme Court, the Supreme Court ruled in their favor, establishing positive legal precedents which benefitted other church members.
