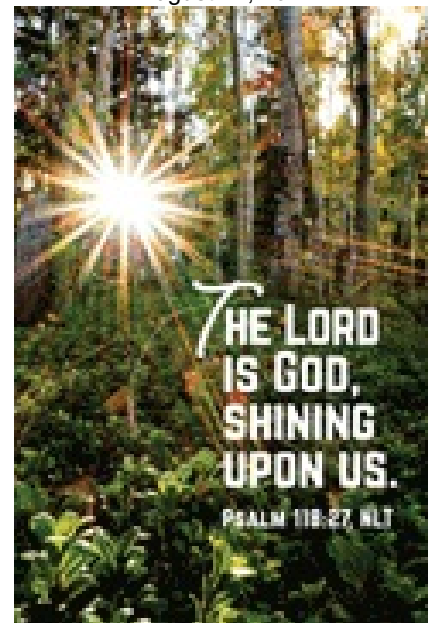

Music Notes

The words to our opening hymn today, "A Shelter in the Time of Storm," were penned in 1880 by Vernon Charlesworth.

Charlesworth was trained as a minister at Homerton College, England. However, in 1869 he was appointed as headmaster of Charles Spurgeon's Stockwell Orphanage near London, England. This was a home which had been started for fatherless children to be fed and educated without charge. This hymn, written around 1880, is said to have been a favorite of the fishermen on the north coast of England. They were often heard singing it as they approached their harbors in the time of storm. It reminds us that we are safe during life's storms with Jesus as our shelter.
