

Music Notes

"Sweet, Sweet Spirit" by Doris Akers (1923 - 1995) is called a "national treasure" by the Smithsonian Institute. One Sunday morning in 1962 she said to her racially mixed church choir, Sky Pilot Choir, "You are not ready to go in." She didn't believe they had prayed enough. She asked them to spend more time in prayer, which they did with renewed fervor. She hated to stop this prayer time, so she told the choir, "We have to go do the service, but there is such a sweet, sweet Spirit in this place." The next day she wrote the song we will sing today. As you sing, pray that this Sweet, Sweet Spirit will fill our church this morning.
