Eliza Hewitt (1851-1920) was born in Philadelphia. After graduating as valedict orian from high school she became a teacher. This ended when she suffered a debilitating back injury and became bed-ridden for an extended period of time. During her convalescence she studied English literature, however, felt a need to be useful to her church. She began writing poems for the Primary Department of her Presbyterian Church.
