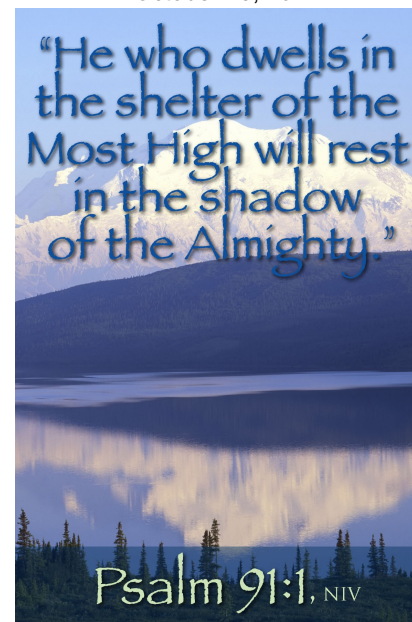

### **Music Notes**

This weekend many churches are celebrating the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation. "A Mighty Fortress" is one of the hymns Martin Luther (1483 - 1546) wrote in the language of the people. It is based on Psalm 46, as a "Hymn of Comfort." Scholars believe it was written between 1527-1528, during one of the darkest times in his life. His six month old daughter died, a plague broke out in Wittenburg, a person following his teaching was martyred, going thru temptation and dealing with controversy in the church. All these struggles caused Luther to cling to his Lord, who is the Mighty Fortress of all who trust in Him.
