### **Music Notes**

"Come Thou Almighty King" appeared anonymously in London, England, about 1757 to commemorate Trinity Sunday. During the Revolutionary War, British soldiers entered a Long Island Church on a Sunday morning and ordered the congregation to sing "God Save the King." (tune - My Country Tis' of Thee) The congregation responded by singing the words, "Come Thou Almighty King" to the tune of "God Save the King." What better prayer can a church offer than the words of the second verse, "Come, and Thy people bless, and give Thy Word success!"
