Music Notes

Come, Ye Thankful People Come - This hymn was written by Henry Alford, a 19th century Anglican clergyman. At age 16, he committed his life to Christian service, and served nearly half a century as an clergyman. For the last 14 years of his life, he served as dean of the Canterbury Cathedral. In this hymn, Alford used traditional language and imagery of the rural community to lend words of thankfulness for God's provision. The final verse points us to the First/Second Coming, "Even so Lord quickly come."
