Joy to The World - Isaac Watts (1674-1748) was born to Dissenting parents (people who refused to accept the authority and practices of the Church of England). As a boy, he sang hymns outside prison walls to encourage his father, who had been arrested for his non-conformist beliefs. As he grew up he became unhappy with the hymns sung in church. His father issued him a challenge, do something about it. The lyrics to "Joy to the World" were written while meditating on Psalm 98.

While this hymn is sung at Christmas, it is not about the Christmas story, however Christ's second coming. Or is it? After all, there is no second coming without a first coming!
