## Music Notes

*O Come Immanuel* - This haunting carol of the ninth century still hints of its Gregorian chant origins. In its original form, "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" was known as a song of the "Great Antiphons." The initial seven Latin verses, represented the different biblical views of the Messiah. One verse per day was sung or chanted during the last seven days before Christmas.

For the people of the Dark Ages—few of whom read or had access to the Bible—the song was an example of the story of how the New and Old Testament views of the Messiah came together in the birth and life of Jesus. Because it brought the story of Christ the Savior to life during hundreds of years of ignorance and darkness, "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" ranks as one of the most important songs in the history of the Christian faith. Our hymn book has three of the seven verses. Notice the names of Jesus - Immanuel, Wisdom, Desire of Nations, Son of God. May this longing for Immanuel make a difference in our lives this Christmas season.
