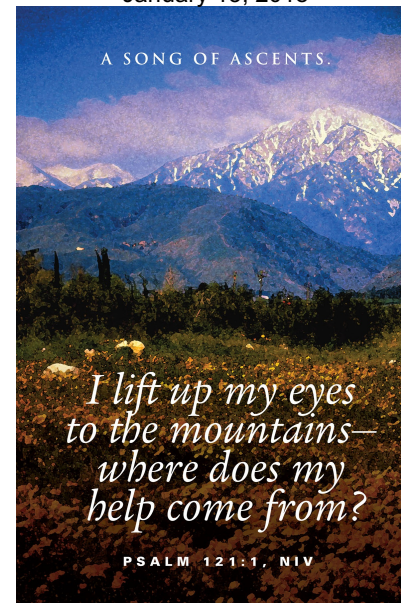

It is believed that Dallán lost his sight, which inspired the first line, "Be Thou my vision".
