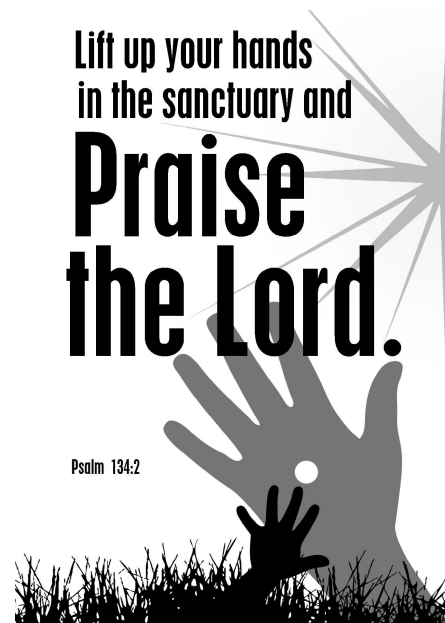

### **Music Notes**

The famous hymn write Ira Sankey reports "The well-known missionary and consecration hymn, "I'll Go Where You Want Me to Go" was adopted by a class of over a hundred missionary nurses at the Battle Creek (Michigan) Sanitarium as their class hymn. Every Sunday afternoon they would gather for a social meeting and always sing [it]...In this class were students from nearly every State of the Union, from Australia, South Africa, South America, Bulgaria, Armenia, and nearly all the European countries. At the close of the course they agreed that after they had parted and gone to their different fields, they would sing this hymn every Sunday as they had done during their happy class-days." This is an excellent idea! How about partnering with a Godly friend and sing and pray for each other the same time each week, no matter what. As Christians, knowing we have others praying for us, makes the load we carry in life.....well, bearable!
