"All That Thrills My Soul" was written by Thorough Harris (1874-1955). Nothing is known of his childhood and youth. Of interest to SDA's is that he attended Battle Creek College. After graduation he moved to Boston where he entered the music publishing business. In 1902 he produced the first of many hymnals and song collections. Sounds ordinary? He was born eleven years after the Civil War ended and our country was going thru incredible challenges. What makes his accomplishments significant, is that he was African American. May we desire that, "all that thrills our soul is JESUS!"
