## Music Notes

Savior, Like a Shepherd Lead Us," attributed to Englishwoman Dorothy A. Thrupp (1779-1847), is found in over 1,005 hymnbooks. Originally this was a hymn for teaching children.

In the first stanza, Christ is portrayed as a caring shepherd. Stanza two continues with Christ as the Good Shepherd however adds being in fellowship with Him.

The third stanza offers a picture of the salvation message of Christ—that no one is beyond the reach of God's love. Stanza four reminds us that the original focus of the hymn was on children, "Early let us seek Thy favor, early let us do thy will." The picture we get from this hymn is a message of hope, saving love, and salvation. Feel free to hum along!
