## Music Notes

All the Way My Saviour Leads Me is considered one of Fannie Crosby's best known hymns. "Jesus doeth all things well." It probably wasn't always easy for Fanny Crosby to believe that. When she was only six weeks old, she lost her sight because of a doctor's error. "I have always believed," she said, "that the good Lord, in His infinite mercy, by this means consecrated me to the work that I am still permitted to do." This particular hymn was written on a day when Fannie needed five dollars and didn't know where she would get it. She prayed about it, and a few minutes later a stranger came to her door and handed her that exact amount.

She was amazed at the Lord's marvelous answer to her simple prayer. "I have no way of accounting for this," she wrote, "except to believe that God, in answer to my prayer, put it into the heart of this good man to bring the money." My first thought was, "It is so wonderful the way the Lord leads me." Jesus still leads today and someday soon we will be singing thru eternity  
"Jesus Led Me All the Way."
