Music Notes

Spirit Song - composed by John Wimber (1934-1997) one of the 20th century's leading charismatic pastors. Stanza one begins with an image of Christ, inviting "The Son of God" to "enfold" the worshipers "with his Spirit and love." The song encourages an intimate relationship between the singer and Christ through the ministry of the Holy Spirit. If the singer will surrender "all the things that hold you," the Holy Spirit will descend "like a dove... upon your life and make you whole." The refrain is a petition to Jesus to "come and fill your lambs." The repetition of Jesus' name and the simple words provide a musical mantra. Let that be our prayer this morning, for the Spirit to come and fill this congregation and make us whole.
