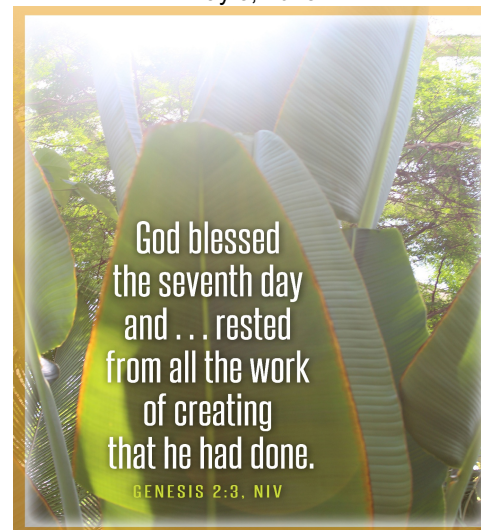

All Creatures of Our God and King - St. Francis of Assisi, who was born in 1181 in what is now Italy, is credited with the lyrics to "All Creatures of Our God and King." The lyrics are adapted from "The Canticle of the Sun", a poem he wrote during the last year of his life. Written at a time when he was weak and struggled with periods of temporary blindness, St. Francis wished to express the unity he felt with nature and the feelings of peace he experienced as his earthly life drew to a close. Nature is frequently referred to as "God's Second Book." This week as you are out and about in our Father's world, you also can experience the peace He offers.
