### *Music Notes*

Today Mark is singing his arrangement of "O Jesus I Have Promised." A few years ago we visited John E. Bode's church in Castle Camps, England. At one time the Castle Camp church was in the center of town. However, during an epidemic of the plague, the townspeople moved the village about a mile away from the church. When a new church was built in the new village, the number of people who made one mile journey to the old church decreased. It was this decrease that caused Bode to consider leaving the ministry. While most sources claim the hymn was written for his children's confirmation, the church historian at Castle Camps disagrees. In 1868 John Ernest Bode was wrestling with whether he should remain a pastor or seek a job as a professor. After a night of prayer he wrote the hymn text, "O Jesus, I Have Promised." He remained at the church until his death in 1874 and is buried in the church yard.
