Music Notes

The Church is one Foundation -

If you had known Samuel Stone, chances are that you might have admired him on one hand and been distressed by his behavior on the other. A priest of the Church of England, he devoted himself to serving the poor and vulnerable, but his athletic build and intense passion sometimes led him afar. It is said that, on one occasion, he gave a thorough beating to a man whom he found mistreating a little girl.

Stone served as a passionate defender, not only of the poor and vulnerable, but also of the faith. He was inspired to write "The Church's One Foundation" in response to a church controversy. This hymn is based on article 9 of The Apostles Creed. It is the only one of those hymns that is still widely sung today. Samuel Wesley, the grandson of Charles Wesley, wrote the music for this hymn.
