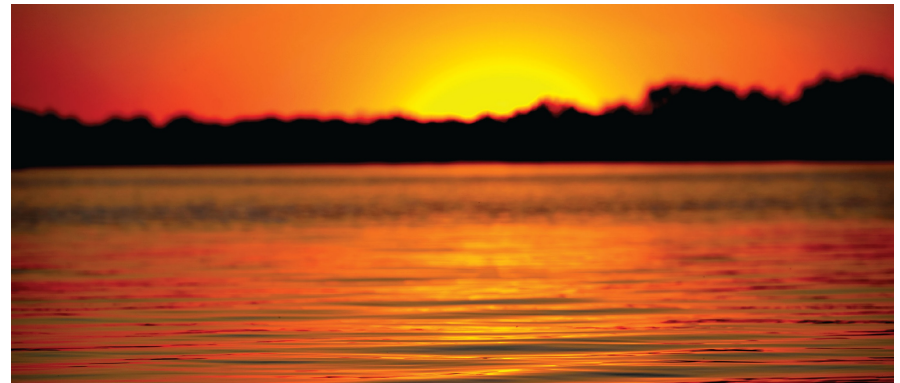

Music Notes

The words of our first hymn this morning, "The God of Abraham Praise," were written by Thomas Oliver. Orphaned at age 4, he was bounced around from relative to relative. Eventually he was apprenticed to a shoemaker. While in London in 1770, Thomas Oliver went to hear a renowned Jewish cantor by the name of Myer Lyon, at the Great Synagogue in London. This is a building that would later be destroyed by the Blitz in World War II. That night, Lyon sang the Yigdal, a song dating back to the 1400's. It prayerfully speaks of the majesty of God. After the service Oliver met with Lyon. The collaboration resulted in transforming a Jewish prayer to a Christian hymn, 12 verses! As you reflect on the words to this majestic hymn, may you find a reason to praise God - Abraham's God and ours.
