Music Notes

I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say - Dr. Horatio Bonar's original title for this hymn was "The Voice from Galilee." The change from minor to major in the middle of the hymn highlights the before and after of coming to Jesus. Stanza one echoes the invitation "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden (Matthew 11:28). Stanza two references the conversation with the Samaritan woman by Jacob's well (John 4:14), and finally verse three draws upon John 8:12, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." Today listen for Jesus voice, He will give you peace.
