Today we extend a special welcome to the Valley Clarinet Choir, directed by Tim Price. They will be providing special music, prelude and offertory. Members include Tim Price, Contrabass Clarinet (and amazing director) David Huddleston and Bonnie MacMillian on the Bass Clarinet, Sandy Price, Cheryl Hubbard, Judie Hanley and Kris Haynal on Bb Clarinet and Brian Renzelman on both the Bb and Eb Clarinets.

The clarinet has its roots in the early single - reed instruments used in Ancient Greece. The modern clarinet developed from a Baroque instrument called the Chalumeau. Around the turn of the 18th century, the chalumeau was modified to produce the first clarinet, and by the time of Beethoven, the clarinet was a standard fixture in the orchestra.

Psalm 150 exhorts us, "Everything that has breath, Praise the Lord." Whether it is singing or playing the clarinet, today, Praise the Lord!!
