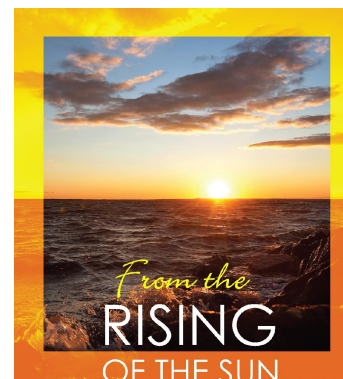

Music Notes

"O Sing a Song of Bethlehem" was written by Louis Fitzgerald Benson (1855-1930). Benson was born in Philadelphia, trained first in law, he also was an ordained Presbyterian minister and is still known as one of America's finest hymnologists. "O Sing" tells the story of Jesus' birth, growth to adulthood, ministry, and death and resurrection in four stanzas. Many hymns do not last more than one generation. The timelessness of this text, written over 100 years ago, has made this a lasting hymn. Benson speaks to commonalities of the human experience—the desire to hear angels, the enjoyment of flower and field, the craving for peace, and the longing for a mighty Savior. May singing this hymn today, bring you peace and give you assurance of a Savior.
