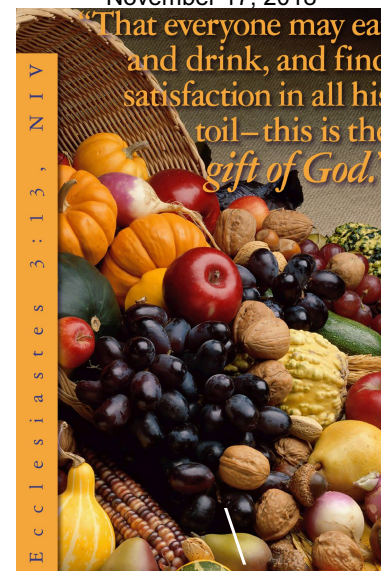

Music Notes

"Under His Wings" was written by William Cushing (1823-1902) who served as a Unitarian pastor for many years. He was well known as a kind and compassionate man whose love for Jesus was acted out daily. Story has it that he gave his life savings so a blind girl could receive an education. Later in life William lost his voice due to some sort of vocal paralysis. He prayed asking how God could possibly use him. God DID use him. He wrote more than three hundred hymns and gospel songs, many which still inspire and encourage us today. At age 73, he was reading Psalm 17:8 "Hide me under the shadow of Your wings." He realized that God still loved and cared and was providing his every need, even when things were difficult. He wrote, "Under His Wings I am safely abiding." What a promise! Isn't it great to know that God is faithful?
