The Garden Club meets on the 3rd Tuesday from September through May. They meet in the Fellowship Center at 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

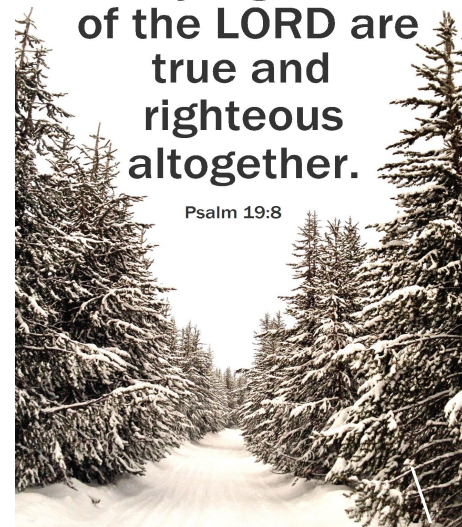
